- 4. Citizens Communications. *Mike Drynan asked that something be done about the tar on Kelly Lane. Jim DuBois thanked Lane Jones for the lime wash and attention to issues on Kelly Lane.*
- 5. Presentation of award by District Attorney Brett Smith. *Grayson County District Attorney Brett Smith and Assistant District Attorney Bi Hunt presented Lt. Adam Huttash with an award for the level of care given to an adolescent patient and his court testimony which lead to conviction.*

- made a motion to approve the replat as presented. Robert Jaska seconded the motion and the motion passed unanimously.
- 25. Consider and take any action necessary regarding an amendment to the Van Alstyne Community Development Corporation's Fiscal Year 2018 2019 budget. CDC President Chris Dorak detailed the proposed amendment. Ryan Neal made a motion to approve the amendment to the Van Alstyne Community Development Corporation's Fiscal Year 2018 2019 budget as requested. Marla Butler seconded the motion and the motion passed unanimously.
- 26. Consider and take any action necessary regarding adopting an ordinance setting the dates, time and place for the public hearing to consider updates to the Land Use Assumptions, Capital Improvement Plan and Water and Wastewater Impact Fees amendments. Bob Johnson detailed the Capital Improvement Advisory Committee's role in evaluating, considering and recommending updates every five years. Only growth facilities are eligible for the Capital Improvement Program. Water Capital Improvement Projects total over twenty-four million dollars. Wastewater Capital Improvement Projects total over sixty-two million dollars. Discussion was held regarding impact fee calculations, current fees compared to other north Texas cities, who pays impact fees and next steps. Robert Jaska made a motion to adopt the ordinance setting the date, time and place for the public hearing to consider updates to the Land Use Assumptions, Capital Improvement Plan and Water and Wastewater Impact Fees amendments. Lee Thomas seconded the motion and the motion passed unanimously.
- 27. Consider and take any action necessary regarding adopting an ordinance amending Van Alstyne Code of Ordinances, Chapter 32 regarding signs and other advertising. *Consideration and action tabled per Mayor Riley*.
- 28. Consider and take any action necessary regarding adoption of an ordinance authorizing the issuance and sale of City of Van Alstyne, Texas Combination Tax and Revenue Certificates of Obligation, Taxable Series 2019; levying an annual ad valorem tax and providing for the security for and payment of said certificates of obligation; providing an effective date; and enacting other provisions relating to the subject. *Jim Sabonis detailed the sale, taxable versus nontaxable, the interest rate obtained and that the interest and sinking property tax rate will not be increased by the addition of this debt. Ryan Neal made a motion to adopt the ordinance as presented. Marla Butler seconded the motion and the motion passed unanimously.*
- 29. Consider and take any action necessary regarding appointments to fill two open places on the Parks and Recreation Board. Ryan Neal made a motion to appoint Amber Edwards and Dennis Gaubatz to fill the two open places on the Parks and Recreation Board. Lee Thomas seconded the motion and the motion passed with Ryan Neal, Lee Thomas, Marla Butler and Robert Jaska in favor and Katrina Arsenault abstaining.
- 30. Consider and take any action necessary regarding appointments to serve on the Planning and Zoning Commission Place 1, Place 5, Place 3, Alternate Place 1 and Alternate Place 2. Ryan Neal made a motion to appoint Jim Atchison to Place 1, Bob Hendricks to Place 5, Larry Cooper to Place 3, Randy Pettit to Alternate Place 1 and Mike Drynan to Alternate Place 2. Robert Jaska seconded the motion and the motion passed unanimously.
- 31. City Manager's Report. City Manager Lane Jones provided a report detailing activities of the prior month, rapid new residential home permitting and financials for fiscal year 2018 2019 periods one through nine.
- 32. Mayor and Council Closing Comments. Robert Jaska thanked citizens, volunteers, small business owners and City staff as well as announced various upcoming community events. Mayor Riley encouraged community involvement and input.
