- 8. Consider and take any action necessary regarding an ordinance amending Section 2-183, "City Fee Schedule Adopted" of the Van Alstyne Code of Ordinances to add a fee for master plan review.

Marla Butler seconded the motion and the motion passed unanimously.*
- 12. Consider and take any action necessary regarding a voluntary annexation request by the owner/agent of an approximate 59.535 acre tract of land being a certain tract of land located in Grayson County, Texas, being a tract of land situated in the J. McKinney Survey, Abstract No. 770, City of Van Alstyne, Grayson County, Texas, the subject tract being a portion of a tract conveyed to L.D. Spence and wife, Ruth Spence, by deed recorded in Volume 841, Page 660 of the Deed Records of Grayson County, Texas. The subject property is generally located at the north west corner of Spence Rd and N. Waco St. *Jennifer Gould advised that the voluntary annexation request has been rescinded. No action taken.*
- 13. Consider and take any action necessary regarding authorizing the City Manager to hire a Code Compliance Officer. Lane Jones detailed the need for code enforcement as well as animal control. Funding for the position exists and is available in the administrative budget. Robert Jaska made a motion to authorize the City Manager to hire a Code Compliance Officer. Katrina Arsenault seconded the motion and the motion passed unanimously.
