The subject property is situated in the T.J. Paxton Survey, Abstract No. 953, Grayson County, Texas, and is generally located on the north side of West FM 121 (West Van Alstyne Parkway) approximately 700 feet west of Collin McKinney Parkway. (*Watson Rezoning Request*)
- 16. Consider and take action on an Ordinance rezoning a 4.00-acre tract of land following annexation from an A, Agricultural Zoning District to a C-2, General Commercial Zoning District. The subject property is situated in the T.J. Paxton Survey, Abstract No. 953, Grayson County, Texas, and is generally located on the north side of West FM 121 (West Van Alstyne Parkway) approximately 700 feet west of Collin McKinney Parkway. (Watson Rezoning Request)

- 17. Consider and take action on an Ordinance amending Van Alstyne Code of Ordinances Chapter 6 regarding animal care and control.
