5. Review Fine Free Policy

a. There are two places in the Fine Free Policy that need to be updated to state that if a patron's library privileges are revoked, this will never include computer access. Computers are always available for public use.

6. Little Big Town 5K

- a. The Board would like to participate in the 5K in early May to help promote the library. We'd like to invite the Friends to participate, also. We'll order team t-shirts from a local vendor.
- 7. Librarian's report: Items of note:
 - a. Memorandum of Understanding with Friends is complete and approved City Attorney has approved this document.
 - b. We hope to receive data from the Anna Library, as they prepare to build their new facility.
 - c. The library has won several grants, including one for 20 new hot spots.
