Pavement Project set on FM 121 in Van Alstyne

PARIS – Texas Department of Transportation officials today announced that a pavement re-surfacing project will begin July 25 in Van Alstyne, Texas, in Grayson County.

The project will extend from the intersection of FM 121 and Main Street in Van Alstyne to State Highway 160. The target completion date for this project is Jan. 30, 2026.

The contractor, DL Lennon Incorporated, Commerce, Texas, was granted 477 working days, weather permitting, to complete this project valued at more than \$10.7 million, officials said.

The contractor will replace culverts, widen the existing roadway, add additional flexible base, resurface the pavement, and install new pavement markings. This work will require daily lane closures during daylight hours. Traffic flaggers and pilot cars will be in place to direct traffic through work zones, officials said. Travelers are asked to reduce their speed and always watch for workers along this portion of FM 121.

Motorists who frequently travel in this area are asked to pay special attention to all barricades, traffic controls and signs, and to reduce their speed as they approach and travel through work zones. They should also avoid distractions such as cell phones, eating, drinking, or car audio or navigation systems.
